

CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 6612

AN ORDINANCE 1) authorizing execution of a two-year interlocal agreement (and supplements if necessary) with the Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT) to accept up to \$204,946 of state funds to support the City's Commute Trip Reduction (CTR) program; and 2) amending the 2021-2022 Operating Grants, Donations and Special Reserves Fund to increase the appropriation by \$153,702.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute a two-year interlocal agreement (and supplements if necessary) with the Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT) to accept up to \$204,946 of state funds to support the City's Commute Trip Reduction (CTR) program, a copy of which Interlocal Agreement shall be substantially in the form given Clerk's Receiving No. 78724.

Section 2. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to receive monies and to expend the same as authorized in said Interlocal Agreement.

Section 3. At the time of execution of said Interlocal Agreement and acceptance of said funds, a project shall be established within the Operating Grants, Donations, and Special Reserves Fund into which all said respective monies shall be deposited.

Section 4. The City Manager or his designee shall have responsibility for the administration of said monies and shall have all authority necessary to enter into agreements regarding the use thereof including purchase agreements to expend funds as provided in said Interlocal Agreement.

Section 5. Upon execution of said Interlocal Agreement, the budget for 2021-2022 Operating Grants, Donations, and Special Reserves Fund shall be amended by appropriating \$153,702 to said fund.

Provided, however, if the actual revenue received from the anticipated sources specified in said Interlocal Agreement shall be more or less than the anticipated amount set forth herein, the appropriations shall be adjusted to equal the amount actually received.

Section 6. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after passage and legal publication
