

- 46 1. The driver/applicant has committed more than three moving violations in the three years
47 before the day on which the individual applies for a permit;
48 2. The driver/applicant has been convicted, which, for purposes of this permit, includes a
49 plea in abeyance, in the seven years before the day on which the individual applies for the
50 permit, of any of the following: driving under the influence of alcohol or drugs; fraud; a
51 sexual offense; a felony involving a motor vehicle; a crime involving property damage; a
52 crime involving theft; a crime of violence; or an act of terror;
53 3. The driver/applicant is required to register as a sex offender in accordance with Title 77,
54 Chapter 41, Sex and Kidnap Offender Registry;
55 4. The driver/applicant does not have a valid Utah driver's license; or
56 5. The driver/applicant is not at least 19 years of age.

58 C. Renewal of For-Hire Driver's Permit: The for-hire driver's permit shall be renewed
59 annually. The applicant for renewal shall submit an application on the form provided by the city
60 if the applicant's permit has not been suspended, revoked, or expired. Along with the renewal
61 application, applicant shall submit to the Licensing Officer a Utah criminal background check
62 which was issued within the past 45 days and the applicant's driving history for the past year
63 from all states the applicant held a driver's license during that time. The applicant shall also
64 include payment of the permit fee, unless any of the conditions for the denial, suspension or
65 revocation of the permit are present as set forth in this article or a disqualifying status is present.


67 **Section 3. Severability.** If any provision of this Ordinance is declared to be invalid by a court of
68 competent jurisdiction, the remainder shall not be affected thereby.

69 **Section 4. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon posting in the
70 manner required by law.
