

CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

RESOLUTION NO. 9904

A RESOLUTION ratifying an emergency contract with Road Construction Northwest, in the amount of \$772,930.00, plus all applicable taxes, executed pursuant to the Emergency Declaration (date 12/4/2020) for the emergency repair or replacement of the Vasa Creek culvert, located near 15321 SE Newport Way, Bellevue, WA 98006.

WHEREAS, a public health and safety hazard, and threat to city infrastructure, continues to exist near 15321 SE Newport Way, Bellevue, WA 98006; and

WHEREAS, this hazard and threat is caused by voids and anomalies of significance between the road's subgrade and the metal corrugated pipe culvert conveying Vasa Creek; and

WHEREAS, the pipe has significantly degraded with the passage of time, allowing water to escape the culvert and infiltrate the subgrade soils; and

WHEREAS, if the culvert is not immediately repaired or replaced, then there is a real and imminent risk of road instability and/or failure due to the water infiltrating the soil below the roadway; and

WHEREAS, an emergency culvert repair or replacement project is required to be developed and implemented expeditiously to protect the public's health, safety, and welfare; to protect property and the environment; and to protect the City's infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, on December 4, 2020, the City Manager declared a state of emergency to facilitate the City's response to the pending hazard and threat; and

WHEREAS, on January 25, 2021, the City Council previously ratified the existence of the emergency with Resolution No. 9880; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council hereby ratifies the emergency contract (dated March 4, 2021) with Road Construction Northwest; in the amount of \$772,930.00, plus all applicable taxes; to perform culvert repair, address subgrade voids and anomalies, and address other associated utility impacts to mitigate hazards and safety risk to the public; and which is authorized pursuant to the Emergency

Declaration signed by the City Manager on December 4, 2020. A copy of the emergency contract (dated March 4, 2021) has been given Clerk's Receiving No. _____.
