

CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 6606

AN ORDINANCE (1) authorizing execution of a grant agreement (and supplements if necessary), with the Department of Ecology to accept reimbursement grant funds in the amount of \$183,467, with a required City of Bellevue 25% match in local contribution (\$61,156), for a total grant agreement of \$244,623, to implement waste reduction and recycling outreach and education programs for 2021-2023; and (2) amending the 2021-2022 Operating Grants, Donations, and Special Reserves Fund to increase the appropriation by \$189,623 to cover the anticipated expenditures in this biennium.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute a grant agreement (and supplements if necessary), with the Department of Ecology to accept reimbursement grant funds in the amount of \$183,467, with a required City of Bellevue 25% match in local contribution (\$61,156), for a total grant agreement of \$244,623, to implement waste reduction and recycling outreach and education programs for 2021-2023, a copy of which grant agreement has been given Clerk's Receiving No. 78608.

Section 2. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to receive monies and to expend the same as authorized in the grant agreement referenced in Section 1.

Section 3. The City Manager or his designee shall have responsibility for the administration and expenditure of the funds received through the grant agreement referenced in Section 1 and shall have all authority necessary to enter into agreements regarding the use thereof.

Section 4. Upon execution of the grant agreement and acceptance of said funds, as described in Section 1, a project shall be established within the Operating Grants, Donations, and Special Reserves Fund into which all said respective grant monies shall be deposited.

Section 5. The City's 2021-2022 Operating Grants, Donations, and Special Reserves Fund appropriation adopted by Ordinance No. 6557 on December 14, 2020, as previously amended, is hereby further amended to increase the appropriation to said fund in the amount of \$189,623 to cover the anticipated expenditures in this biennium; provided, however, if the actual revenue received from the anticipated sources specified in the grant agreement referenced in Section

1 shall be more or less than the anticipated amount set forth herein, the appropriations to the Operating Grants, Donations, and Special Reserves Fund shall be adjusted to be equal to the amount actually received.

Section 6. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage and legal publication.
