ORDINANCE 2012-38.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CONSOLIDATED FEE SCHEDULE WITH
REGARD TO RECREATION CENTER FEES. (12-141)

WHEREAS, pursuant to the authority granted in Utah Code 11-2-3, Provo City is granted authority to designate and build indoor recreation centers and establish guidelines for the operations and Chapter 3.09.010 of the Provo City Code allows for changes to the Consolidated Fee Schedule to defray costs; and

WHEREAS, for the benefit of the community, Provo City offers recreational opportunities for the benefit of the community and is nearing completion on the new Provo City Recreation Center; and

WHEREAS, Provo City commissioned a study, which study examined the feasibility of altering the fee schedule to account for different classes and performed a cost comparison against other facilities throughout the country and Utah County; and

WHEREAS, on October 2, 2012, the Parks and Recreation Department presented early findings to Municipal Council during a Work Session meeting; and

WHEREAS, the Municipal Council requested the Parks and Recreation Department to engage the public in the details of the revised fee schedule and this step has been completed; and

WHEREAS, on November 13, 2012, the Municipal Council held a duly noticed public meeting to ascertain the facts regarding this matter, which facts and comments are found in the meeting record; and

WHEREAS, after considering the facts presented to the Municipal Council, the Council finds (i) the Consolidated Fee Schedule should be amended and (ii) said amendment reasonably furthers the health, safety and general welfare of the citizens of Provo City;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Municipal Council of the City of Provo, Utah, as follows:

PART I:

The Consolidated Fee Schedule is hereby amended as shown in Exhibit A. The Parks and Recreation Center fees shall be as set forth in the amended Consolidated Fee Schedule, except as may be later amended by the Municipal Council.

PART II:

This ordinance shall take effect immediately after being posted or published as required by law.
