

ORDINANCE NO. 702

AN ORDINANCE of the City Council of the City of Lakewood, Washington, amending Chapter 3.09 of the Lakewood Municipal Code relating to City Funds.

WHEREAS, the City is committed to transparency with public funds; and

WHEREAS, the City creates funds for particular purposes; and

WHEREAS, there are two such funds relating to sewer capital improvement; and

WHEREAS, having one such fund is more transparent; and

WHEREAS, the City has the authority to designate funds;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAKEWOOD, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN as Follows:

Section 1. That Section 3.09.210 Sewer Capital Project of the Lakewood Municipal Code is hereby amended as follows:

**3.09.210 Sewer capital project.**

There is hereby established a fund known as the sewer capital project fund (fund 311) as follows:

A. Purpose. The purpose of this fund is to account for the construction and expansion of a sewer system and related administrative costs to maintain and operate the fund. The purpose of this fund is to account for the construction of a sewer system that was donated to Pierce County.

B. Revenues. Primary revenue sources are grants, contributions, public works trust fund loans, sewer surcharges and sewer availability charges. [Ord. 589 § 22, 2014.]

Section 2. That Section 3.09.220 Sanitary Sewer Connection Capital Project is here by repealed.

~~There is hereby established a fund known as the sanitary sewer connection capital project fund (fund 312) as follows:~~

~~A. Purpose. The purpose of this fund is to account for the revenues generated from the sewer availability charges, expenditures and transfers that are legally allowable for sewer availability charge fees and for administrative expenses to maintain and operate the fund.~~

~~B. Revenues. Sewer availability charges imposed under Chapter 12.15 LMC. [Ord. 589 § 23, 2014.]~~


Section 3. Severability. If any portion of this Ordinance or its application to any person or circumstances is held invalid, the remainder of the Ordinance or the application of the provision to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected.


Section 4. Effective Date. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect thirty (30) days after publication of the Ordinance Summary.
