ORDINANCE NO. 6545

AN ORDINANCE 1) authorizing execution of an agreement for a Public Assistance grant agreement (and supplements, if necessary) with the Washington State Military Department (WSMD) and Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) to accept up to \$320,000 in grant funding to support the design and construction of repairs on SE 11th Street for damaged public facilities for incident(s) occurring between January 10, 2020 and February 10, 2020; 2) amending the 2019-2020 General Capital Investment Program (CIP) Fund to increase the appropriation by \$320,000 with the acceptance of the WSMD and FEMA grant; 3) amending the 2019-2025 CIP Plan to increase the budget for the Major Maintenance Program (CIP Plan No. PW-M-19) by \$320,000; and, 4) authorizing administrative officials to receive and expend funds as authorized in the Grant Agreement.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute a Public Assistance grant agreement (and supplements if necessary) with the Washington State Military Department (WSMD) and Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) to accept up to \$320,000 in grant funding to support the design and construction of repairs on SE 11th Street for damaged public facilities for incident(s) occurring between January 10, 2020 and February 10, 2020, a copy of which grant agreement shall be substantially in the form given Clerk's Receiving No. \_\_\_\_\_.

Section 2. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to receive monies and to expend the same as authorized in said grant agreement.

Section 3. The City Manager or his designee shall have responsibility for the administration of said funds and expenditure of said funds received pursuant to said grant agreement and shall have all authority necessary to enter into agreements regarding the use thereof.

Section 4. The 2019-2020 General Capital Investment Program (CIP) Fund, adopted by Ordinance No. 6493 on December 2, 2019, as previously amended, is hereby further amended to increase the appropriation to said CIP Fund by \$320,000.

Section 5. The City's 2019-2025 CIP Plan, adopted by Ordinance No. 6493 on December 2, 2019, as previously amended, is hereby further amended to increase the budget for the Major Maintenance Program (CIP Plan No. PW-M-19) by \$320,000.

Section 6. If the actual revenue received from the Washington State Military Department (WSMD) and Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) shall be more or less than the anticipated amount set forth herein, the appropriations to the CIP Fund and Plan shall be adjusted to be equal to the amount actually received.

Section 7. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage and legal publication.
