

CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 6557

AN ORDINANCE adopting the City of Bellevue's 2021-2022 Budget and 2021-2027 Capital Investment Program (CIP) Plan; setting forth the estimated revenues and appropriations; establishing job classifications and pay ranges; and establishing an effective date.

WHEREAS, a preliminary biennium budget for 2021-2022 was prepared and filed with the City Clerk as required by law; and

WHEREAS, public hearings were held by the City Council on the preliminary biennium budget and the preliminary 2021-2027 Capital Investment Program Plan, at which time comments for or against any part of the preliminary biennium budget and the preliminary 2021-2027 Capital Investment Program Plan were heard; and

WHEREAS, on July 27, September 21, and November 23, 2020, the City Council held a public hearing upon notice as prescribed by law, and met for the purpose of setting the final budget of the city for the 2021-2022 fiscal biennium and the 2021-2027 Capital Investment Program Plan; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has made adjustments and changes as it deemed necessary or proper and desires to adopt the 2021-2022 Budget and the 2021-2027 Capital Investment Program Plan; and to appropriate monies to each of the City's funds in order to fund expenditures authorized in the 2021-2022 Budget and the 2021-2027 Capital Investment Program Plan; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

The appropriations authorized in the Capital Investment Program above shall be for the purpose of funding those projects set forth in the 2021-2027 Capital Investment Program Plan of the City of Bellevue, Washington, a copy of which has been given Clerk's Receiving No. \_\_\_\_\_.

Section 2. The job classifications and pay ranges for employees of the City, as set forth in the 2021 City of Bellevue Pay Plans, are hereby adopted as part of the biennium budget.

Section 3. All employees who are members of a bargaining unit shall receive such pay and benefits for 2021 as are provided for in the appropriate collective bargaining agreement.

Section 4. The provisions of Sections 1-3 of this ordinance shall take effect on January 1, 2021.

Section 5. The Clerk is directed to transmit a certified copy of this ordinance to the Office of the Auditor of the State of Washington, Division of Municipal Corporations and to the Association of Washington Cities.

Section 6. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage and legal publication.
