ORDINANCE NO. 6609

AN ORDINANCE 1) authorizing execution of a Department of Homeland Security (DHS) subgrant agreement (and supplements if necessary) with the Washington State Military Department to accept grant funds in the amount of \$218,750 for vulnerable populations planning, citizen preparedness and outreach and sustainment; 2) authorizing the deposit of said funds into the Operating Grants, Donations, and Special Reserves Fund in the amount of \$218,750; 3) appropriating unanticipated and future revenues to that fund; and 4) authorizing expenditures of said grant funds.

WHEREAS,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute a Department of Homeland Security (DHS) subgrant agreement (and supplements if necessary) with the Washington State Military Department to accept grant funds in the amount of \$218,750 for vulnerable populations planning, citizen preparedness and outreach and sustainment, a copy of which agreement shall be substantially in the form given Clerk's Receiving No. \_\_\_\_\_.

Section 2. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to deposit said funds into the Operating Grants, Donations, and Special Reserves Fund in the amount of \$218,750.

Section 3. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to appropriate unanticipated and future revenues to that fund; and authorize expenditures of said grant funds.


Section 4. The City Manager or his designee shall have responsibility for the administration of said grant monies and shall have all authority necessary to enter into agreements regarding the use thereof including purchase agreements to expend funds as provided in said grant agreement.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force **five (5)** days after its passage and legal publication.
