

CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 6496

AN ORDINANCE authorizing 1) execution of a grant agreement with the State of Washington Department of Commerce for \$1,009,400; 2) amending the 2019-2020 Biennium General Capital Investment Program (CIP) fund to increase the appropriation by \$1,009,400 for Downtown Park NE Gateway project (CIP Plan No. P-AD-100); and 3) modifying the 2019-2025 CIP Plan to increase Downtown Park NE Gateway project (CIP Plan No. P-AD-100) by \$1,009,400.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute an agreement with the Washington State Department of Commerce to accept \$1,009,400 in grant funds, a copy of which agreement shall be substantially in the form given Clerk's Receiving No. _____.

Section 2. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to receive monies and to expend the same as authorized in said grant agreement.

Section 3. The City Manager or his designee shall have responsibility for the administration of said funds and expenditure of said funds received pursuant to said grant agreement and shall have all authority necessary to enter into agreements regarding the use thereof.

Section 4. The City's 2019-2025 CIP Plan, adopted by Ordinance No. 6493 on December 2, 2019, is amended to increase the budget for the Downtown Park NE Gateway Project (CIP Plan No. P-AD-100) by \$1,009,400.

Section 5. The 2019-2020 General Capital Investment Program (CIP) Fund, adopted by Ordinance No. 6493 on December 2, 2019, is amended to increase the appropriation to said CIP Fund by \$1,009,400.

Section 6. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage and legal publication.
