

3 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CONSOLIDATED FEE SCHEDULE TO
4 ADD A METER READING FEE FOR CUSTOMERS WHO ELECT NOT TO
5 HAVE AN AMI METER. (17-043)

7 WHEREAS, Provo Power customers who opt out of having an AMI meter will require
8 the City to cover additional personnel and equipment maintenance costs that the City would not
9 otherwise incur; and
10

11 WHEREAS, the Provo City Municipal Council has received a recommendation that a fee
12 be added to the Consolidated Fee Schedule in order to recover those costs; and
13

14 WHEREAS, on March 7, 2017 and March 21, 2017, the Municipal Council held duly
15 noticed public meetings to ascertain the facts regarding this matter; and
16

17 WHEREAS, after considering the facts presented to the Municipal Council, the Council
18 finds (i) the Consolidated Fee Schedule should be amended and (ii) said amendment reasonably
19 furthers the health, safety, and general welfare of the citizens of Provo City;

21 NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Municipal Council of the City of Provo, Utah,

53 A. If a provision of this ordinance conflicts with a provision of a previously adopted
54 ordinance, this ordinance shall prevail.

55

56 B. This ordinance and its various sections, clauses and paragraphs are hereby declared to be
57 severable. If any part, sentence, clause or phrase is adjudged to be unconstitutional or
58 invalid, the remainder of the ordinance shall not be affected thereby.

60 C. The Municipal Council hereby directs that the official copy of the Provo City Code be
61 updated to reflect the provisions enacted by this ordinance.

63 D. This ordinance shall take effect immediately after it has been posted or published in
64 accordance with Utah Code 10-3-711, presented to the Mayor in accordance with Utah
65 Code 10-3b-204, and recorded in accordance with Utah Code 10-3-713.
