### NEW BUSINESS

#### **Review of the 2021-2022 Proposed Biennial Budget Department Presentations.**

Senior Policy Analyst Kelley-Fong highlighted the City Council and City Manager 2021-2022 goals, objectives and proposed operating budget.

Assistant City Manager for Development Services Bugher highlighted the Community & Economic Development Department's 2021-2022 goals, objectives and proposed operating budget. Discussion ensued related to the volume of workload, current staffing allocations and proposed fee schedule increases.

Parks, Recreation & Community Services Director Dodsworth highlighted the Parks, Recreation and Community Services 2019-2020 key accomplishments and the 2021-2022 goals, objectives and proposed operating budget. Discussion ensued related to the impacts of the vacant Maintenance Worker position, continuation of community events in the post COVID-19 environment and funding in support of the Lakewood Multicultural Coalition (LMCC).

City Attorney Wachter provided an overview of services provided by the Legal Department. She then highlighted the 2021-2022 goals, objectives and proposed operating budget. Discussion ensued related to decline in revenues received from fines and future ability to collect and training opportunities for new staff members.
